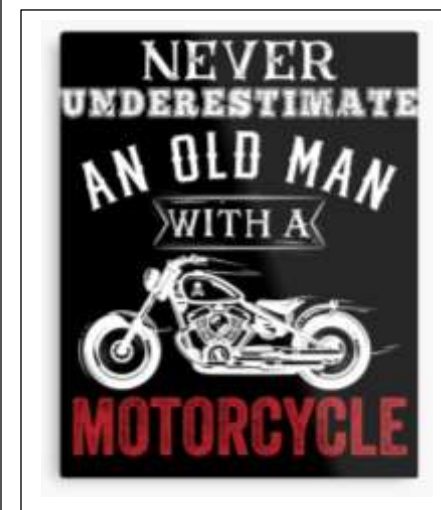

Beautiful Bundanoon. Located 149km south-west of Sydney via Hume Motorway, 18km south of Moss Vale via Sutton Forest and Exeter.

The district was named by the explorer Charles Throsby who passed through in 1818 searching for a route to overland cattle to the South Coast. Throsby named the area Bantanoo. It is believed that 'Bantanoo' is a corruption of a Tharawal (Dharawal) Aboriginal word meaning 'deep ravine' or 'place of deep gullies'. This makes sense as the district is on the edge of the Illawarra plateau and there are plenty of deep gullies nearby. Over time, 'Bantanoo' became 'Bundanoon', further embracing the similarity of style to the Scottish Highlands and becoming the home of Brigadoon : The Bundanoon Highland Gathering held every April.

This is the perfect stop over for motorcycle riders and our club members can often be seen enjoying the sights and hospitality that Bundanoon offers.

OZ WALSH SHIELD PRESENTATION

10 November 2020

The Oz Walsh Shield (Clubman Award) was presented at our last club meeting on 10 November. Club President Bruce Tinsley announced this year's recipient to be Jeff Green and Club Captain Frank Millwood (pictured to the right), made the presentation.

This award is linked to the Club's published calendar for Sunday rides. Changes to the calendar due to cancelled rides or additional rides that are approved at a monthly meeting may also be included. Open rides or changes made on the day (eg unpleasant weather or safety concerns) will have the distance recorded for the ride that is completed. However, if a rider leaves the calendar ride or chooses to extend the ride or not ride with the club group, they will not have the extra distance recorded for the day's ride. The intention is to record the distance covered by those participating in the club ride.

All members of the Classic Riders Club of Goulburn are eligible to participate on club calendar rides and be part of this award process. Visitors, guests and pillions are welcome to join the ride without accruing a distance record. Participating members will only have a distance recorded if they are riding a motorcycle on RMS Conditional Registration or a fully registered motorcycle that is eligible for conditional registration. The motorcycle may be one of their own, borrowed or registered through another club approved as a Historic Club by the RMS.

The Oz Walsh Shield Award is given for the most kilometres ridden in a 12 month period – an achievement which Jeff has managed to secure for several years running.

From its beginning, says Ross Gilchrist, 'the award was only ever intended to be a bit of fun, it's the sort of thing all motoring clubs probably do. It is a tangible part of our club's history as it is in recognition of participation in the club calendar events'.

Club rides are more than the chance to take a motorcycle out of the garage. They are an opportunity each week to meet with club friends, explore the local area and beyond, with the advantage of numbers for a less lonely ride. They offer time to chat over 'what's in the shed', 'mechanical challenges' and 'what to buy next'.

They offer the chance to gather as a club and share a day out.

Congratulations Jeff, your support of our club ride schedule is very much appreciated and we look forward to your continued high participation rate as a beckoning mark for other club members.
